

- India emerged victorious against West Indies by 8 wickets in the Trination Women's Cricket series held in South Africa.
- New Zealand introduced the 'Debbie Hockley Medal' to honor accomplished female cricketers.
- Anurag Singh Thakur and Lieutenant Governor Sh. Manoj Sinha unveiled the 3rd Khelo India Winter Games Mascot, Theme Song, and Jersey at Raj Bhavan, Jammu.
- The Asian Football Confederation (AFC) declared Saudi Arabia as the host for the 2027 Asian Nations Cup, marking their first time hosting since the event's inception in 1956.
- Qatar is set to host the next edition of the Asian Football Cup from June 26 to July 16, 2023.
- Aaron Finch, an Australian cricketer, has announced his retirement from international cricket.
- Kerala emerged as the champions in the inaugural National Beach Soccer Championships.
- The central ice hockey team of Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP) secured victory in the 12th IHAI National Ice Hockey Championship for men in Leh, Ladakh.
- LeBron James has surpassed Kareem Abdul Jabbar's long-standing record to become the all-time leading scorer in the NBA.
- The 5th Khelo India Youth Games saw Maharashtra securing the top spot in the medal table, followed by Haryana and Madhya Pradesh.
- Shri Anurag Singh Thakur inaugurated the 3rd edition of the Khelo India Winter Games in Gulmarg.
- Pakistani wicketkeeper Kamran Akmal has announced his retirement from all forms of cricket.
- The ICC T20 Women's World Cup commenced in South Africa with the opening match between the hosts and Sri Lanka, led by Harmanpreet Kaur from India.

- Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy's government declared Visakhapatnam as the new capital of the state.
- Hon'ble Vice President Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar inaugurated the 36th Surajkund International Crafts Mela, 2023 in Faridabad, Haryana.

- The Kerala government launched the robotic scavenger "Bandicoot" to clean sewages in Guruvayur.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

- The UNESCO World Heritage List added the Ukrainian city of Odessa and included it on the List of World Heritage in Danger.
- The 15th BRICS summit is scheduled to happen in Durban, South Africa, in late August. India will be the Theme Country at the 2025 Madrid International Book Fair.
- Google invested approximately \$300 million in Anthropic, an artificial intelligence startup known for its technology rivaling OpenAI, the creator of ChatGPT.
- India, France, and the UAE established a formal trilateral cooperation initiative for solar and nuclear energy projects, climate change combat, and collaborative military hardware production.
- Australia announced plans to replace the image of Queen Elizabeth II on its \$5 banknote with a design honoring Indigenous culture.
- India and Egypt held the 3rd 'Joint Working Group on Counter Terrorism' meeting in New Delhi. A 7-year-old Prince from Bhutan became the country's first digital citizen.

- Microsoft Research's Project ELLORA is preserving 'rare' Indian languages (Gondi, Mundari, and Idu Mishmi), launched in 2015 to support low-resource languages.
- Google introduced an experimental conversation AI service named "Bard" in competition with the popular ChatGPT from OpenAI.
- India welcomed the Republic of Congo to the International Solar Alliance.
- Significant earthquakes with magnitudes of 7.8 and 7.5 hit southern Turkey and western Syria, causing widespread destruction in both countries.
- India initiated 'Operation Dost' to provide assistance to Turkey and Syria following the devastating earthquake.
- South African President Cyril Ramaphosa declared a "State of Disaster" due to the country's electricity crisis during his annual State of the Nation address in Cape Town.
- The World Government Summit 2023 commenced in Dubai with the theme "Shaping Future Governments."
- External Affairs Minister Dr. S Jaishankar inaugurated the 12th World Hindi Conference in Fiji, co-hosted by the Governments of India and Fiji.
- PM Narendra Modi engaged in a video call with French President H.E. Emmanuel Macron for the launch of the new Air India-Airbus Partnership. Air India will acquire 250 aircraft from Airbus under this partnership.
- India, the US, and Brazil will establish a global biofuel alliance aimed at promoting cooperation and sustainable biofuel utilization.
- Cyclone Gabrielle struck Auckland, the largest city in New Zealand.
- Air India made a historic agreement to purchase 220 Boeing planes for \$34 billion, reflecting the strong economic partnership between Tata-owned airlines and Boeing.
- The Spanish government passed a groundbreaking law providing paid medical leave to women with severe menstrual pain, the first of its kind in Europe.
- Seattle became the first US city to enact an explicit ban on caste-based discrimination, making history.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY NEWS

- Azad Engineering Private Limited, a Hyderabad-based leader in engineering, has been authorized as the first Indian company to provide critical rotating parts for nuclear turbines.
- ISRO and Indian Institute of Technology Madras (IIT Madras) aim to create a training module for the Indian Spaceflight Programme using Augmented Reality / Virtual Reality / Mixed Reality (AR / VR / MR).
- Jupiter now holds the record for the planet with the most moons. Astronomers have identified 12 new moons orbiting Jupiter, bringing the total count to an unprecedented 92. These moons were

spotted through telescopes in Hawaii and Chile in 2021 and 2022, and their orbits were verified through follow-up observations.

- Skye Air introduced India's inaugural Traffic Management System for Drones.
- Skye UTM is a Cloud-based aerial traffic management system that integrates unmanned air traffic with manned aviation airspace.
- The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare launched the nationwide Sarva Dawa Sevan or Mass Drug Administration (MDA) campaign to Eradicate Lymphatic Filariasis (LF).
- NASA-ISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar or NISAR, an Earth science satellite developed collaboratively by NASA and ISRO, operates in Low Earth Orbit (LEO). NISAR is set to map the entire globe within a span of 12 days.
- ISRO successfully initiated the second edition of the Small Satellite Launch Vehicle (SSLV-D2) from the first launch pad of the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh.
- Saudi Arabia is preparing to send its inaugural woman astronaut, Rayyana Barnawi, on a 10-day mission to the International Space Station (ISS) alongside Saudi astronaut Ali Al-Qarni.
- Antaris reported that the world's first satellite entirely conceived, designed, and produced using the company's end-to-end cloud platform, JANUS1, has effectively reached orbit. JANUS-1 was launched aboard the Indian Space Research Organization's (ISRO) SSLV-D2 rocket.
- India's First Hybrid Rocket was launched in Chengalpattu, Tamil Nadu. The Martin Foundation, in collaboration with the Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam International Foundation and Space Zone India, executed the Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Satellite Launch Vehicle Mission-2023.
