ISRO Successfully Launches India's First Solar Mission, Aditya-L1

- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has achieved a successful launch of India's inaugural solar observatory mission, named Aditya-L1, from the Sathish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota.
- This mission was carried out using the PSLV C57 rocket.
- Notably, "L1" in Aditya-L1 refers to Lagrange Point 1.
- The primary goal of this mission is to study the dynamics of the solar upper atmosphere, specifically the chromosphere and corona.
- Aditya-L1 will embark on a journey of approximately 125 days, roughly four months, to reach its designated observation point at L1, where it will unravel the mysteries of the Sun.

- Dr. R Ravi Kannan from India Receives the Ramon Magsaysay Award 2023
 - Dr. R Ravi Kannan, a surgical oncologist based in Assam, India, has been honored with the Ramon Magsaysay Award 2023 for his groundbreaking contributions to cancer treatment in Assam.
 - Before relocating to Silchar in 2007 to join the Cachar Cancer Hospital, he worked at the Cancer Institute in Chennai.
 - The Ramon Magsaysay Award, established in 1957, recognizes individuals for their commitment to governance with integrity, courageous service to the people, and practical idealism in democratic societies.

National & International Appointments

- Indian-Origin Economist Tharman Shanmugaratnam Wins Singapore Presidential Election
 - Tharman Shanmugaratnam, an Indian-origin economist and former Senior Minister, has emerged victorious in the presidential election of Singapore.
 - He secured over 70% of the votes in Singapore's first contested presidential election since 2011.
 - Tharman Shanmugaratnam served as Singapore's Deputy Prime Minister from 2011 to 2019 and has held various ministerial positions.
 - He becomes the third Indian-origin President of Singapore, following in the footsteps of Sellapan Ramanathan and Chengara Veetil Devan Nair.

 - The Government of India has established an eight-member high-level committee tasked with examining the "One Nation, One Election" concept.

- Neeraj Chopra Secures Second Place in Men's Javelin at Zurich Diamond League
 - Indian javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra claimed the second spot in the men's javelin event at the Zurich Diamond League Meeting.
 - He achieved this feat with a final round throw of 85.71 meters.
 - Jakub Vadlejch from the Czech Republic, a bronze medalist at the World Championships, clinched the first position.
 - Neeraj Chopra, the reigning Olympic champion, produced three legal throws of 80.79 meters, 85.22 meters, and 85.71 meters.
 - He has secured a spot in the Diamond League finals, scheduled for September 17 in Eugene, USA.

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Upcoming Visit to Jakarta, Indonesia
