- Soil erodibility assesses the vulnerability of soil particles to detachment and accounts for factors such as rainfall, infiltration, and runoff.

- She is only the second Chinese player, following Shanshan Feng in 2017-18, to reach this pinnacle since the rankings were established in 2006.
- Yin also joins the ranks of Atthaya Thitikul (2022) and Lydia Ko (2015) as the third player aged 20 or younger to achieve No. 1 status.
- At 20 years old, Yin becomes the 18th different player to secure the top spot and the fifth player to do so in the current year, setting a record.

Indian Air Force to Receive First Airbus C-295 Transport Aircraft

- The Indian Air Force is on the verge of acquiring its first Airbus C-295 aircraft.
- The acquisition of 56 Airbus C-295 aircraft has been formalized to replace the Indian Air Force's AVRO fleet.

- Currently, 425 million people consider Hindi their first language, and approximately 120 million speak it as their second language.

RBI Issues Guidelines for Loan Account Settlement

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has issued guidelines instructing all banks, non-banking finance companies (NBFCs), and asset reconstruction companies (ARCs) to release all original movable and immovable property documents and remove charges registered with any registry within 30 days after full repayment or settlement of a loan account.
- In cases where the delay is attributable to the lending institution, it will be required to compensate the borrower at the rate of ₹5,000 for each day of delay.

State Affairs

PM Modi Embarks on a Day-Long Visit to Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh

- In Chhattisgarh, Prime Minister Narendra Modi dedicated significant rail sector projects to the nation.
- The Prime Minister's focus on enhancing connectivity throughout the country received a boost with the inauguration of important rail sector projects worth over Rs. 6,000 crores during a public program in Raigarh.

NASA's Discovery: Distant Planet May Host Water Ocean and Potential Life

- NASA has made an intriguing discovery, suggesting the presence of a rare water ocean on a distant exoplanet located many light years away. Additionally, there are chemical hints of potential life.
- NASA's James Webb Space Telescope, while studying K2-18 b, an exoplanet, detected the presence of carbon dioxide and methane.
- This discovery raises the possibility that K2-18b could be a Hycean exoplanet, potentially featuring a hydrogen-rich atmosphere and a surface covered by a water ocean.

Amazon's AWS Collaborates with ISRO to Advance AI Capabilities

- Cloud giant Amazon Web Services (AWS) has entered into a strategic Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with ISRO (Indian Space Research Organisation) and the Indian National Space Promotion and Authorization Centre (IN-SPACe) to support space-tech innovations through cloud computing.

Cabinet Greenlights Expansion of Ujjwala Yojana

- The Cabinet has approved the expansion of the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY), allocating an additional 7.5 million new LPG connections over a three-year period until FY26.
- This expansion, costing Rs 1,650 crore, will raise the total number of PMUY beneficiaries to 103.5 million.
